All regulatory analyses include a statement of the need for the proposed action, an examination of alternative approaches, and an evaluation of the benefits and costs—quantitative and qualitative—of the proposed action and the main alternatives identified by the analysis.

**Small Entity Economic Impact Analysis/Regulatory Flexibility Analysis:** Examine the impacts of regulations on small entities in accordance with the Regulatory Flexibility Act. Determine whether there is a significant economic impact on a substantial number of small entities and provide factual basis for such determination.

**Environmental Assessment:** Assess the effects of proposed rules on the environment, ensuring that final decisions will be based on sound analysis of environmental impacts following National Environmental Policy Act procedures.

**Paperwork Burden Analysis:** Examine whether there are any data collection and reporting activities associated with a rule, and as necessary, prepare an Information Collection Request in accordance with the Paperwork Reduction Act.

**Energy Impact Analysis:** Analyze whether a rule is expected to affect energy supply, distribution, or consumption in accordance with Executive Order 13211.

**International Trade Impact Analysis:** Assess whether a rule creates unnecessary obstacles to the foreign commerce of the United States.

**Unfunded Mandates Reform Analysis:** Evaluate the impact of a rule on affected State and local governments and private entities in accordance with the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act.

**Public Comment Processing Support:** Review and summarize the details of public comments received in response to a proposed regulation.

**Technical Writing:** Produce rulemaking documents suitable for publication in accordance with the Federal Register Drafting Handbook.
